What is System of Care?

System of Care is a coordinated network of community-based services and supports that are organized to meet the challenges of children and youth with serious mental health needs and their families. System of Care is not a service, but rather a philosophy of how care should be delivered. A community that supports the System of Care philosophy and seeks to promote the full potential of every child and youth by addressing their physical, emotional, intellectual, cultural and social needs by promoting the family as the essential component to creating lasting change.

What is Wraparound?

Wraparound is a values-driven planning and organizing process designed to support families with complex and enduring needs. Wraparound gathers together the important people in the child/youth's life. The Child and Family Team work to create a plan that supports the entire family in achieving their goals.

Benefits of Wraparound

- Instills hope in families
- Develops family skills
- Strengthens the connection between parent and child
- Increases resilience in families
- Builds bridges to natural supports in the community



What to expect from the Child and Family team process?

- Discovery of strengths and needs
- Identification of natural and formal supports
- Individualized plan of care for the whole family, prioritized by the family
- Measurable objectives
- The Wraparound process coordinated transition from formal supports to natural supports

Why does Wraparound work?

Wraparound's unique approach is successful because:

- Individual and family strengths are identified and become the basis for positive change.
- Parents and caregivers are supported by people who know the family best and help develop every aspect of the Plan of Care.
- Each Plan of Care is tailored to match the family's needs, values and culture.
